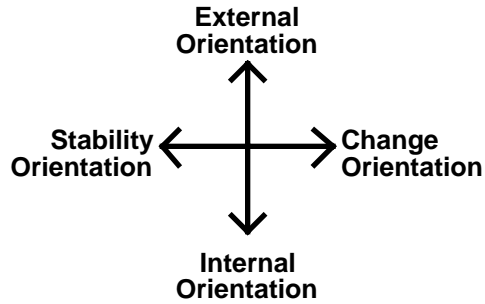

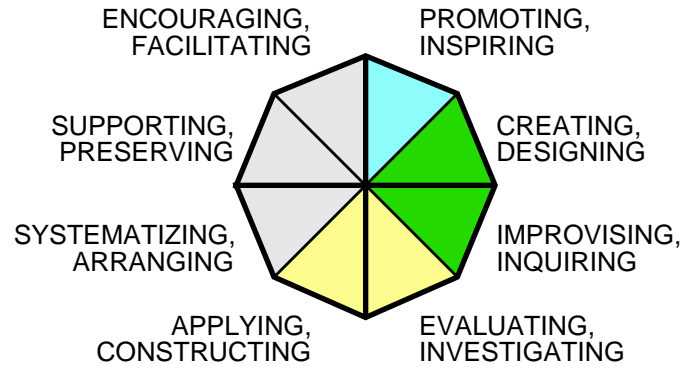
Arrangement of Personality Characteristics



Key: Personality Characteristics

- Pervasive behavior** - what appears to be natural, and is exhibited in many situations.
- Learned behavior** - what one has learned, to do, needs to do, and/or wants to do.
- Basic behavior** - what may be natural, but is not apparent in some situations.
- Occasional behavior** - what is displayed less frequently and in fewer situations.

The characteristic traits are determined by combinations of the corresponding personal styles illustrated in each of the three subsystems of behavior:

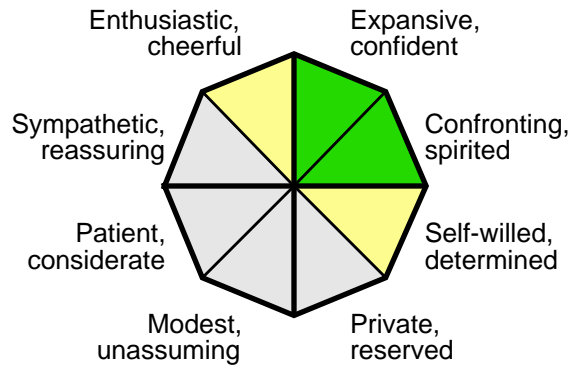

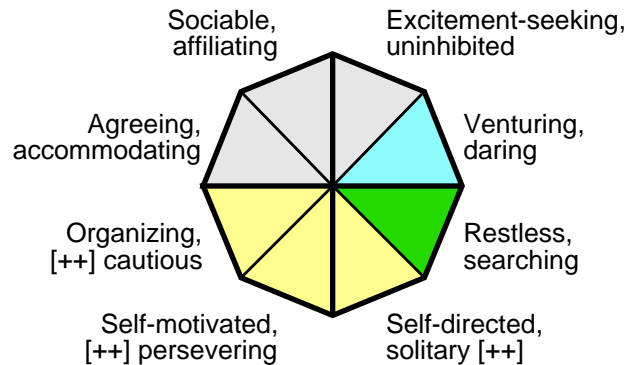

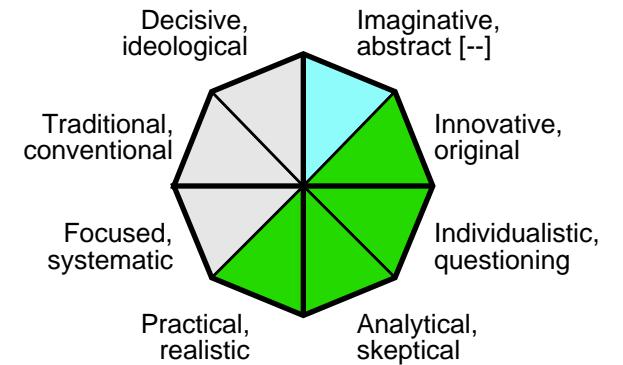
Styles of Emotion
